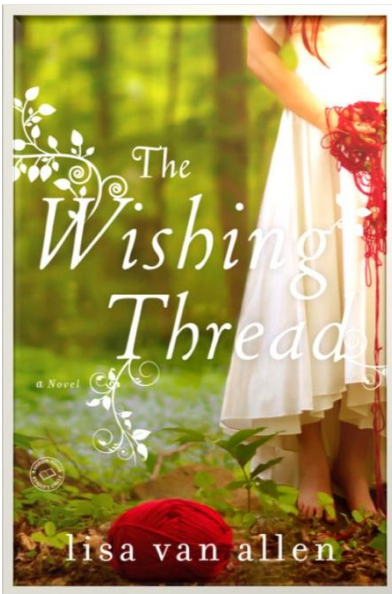

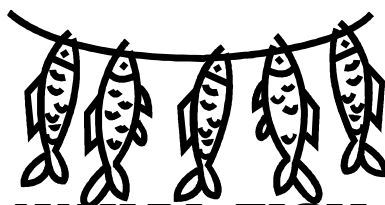
PHYLLIS ROMEO- DISTRICT ART/PERFORMING CHAIRPERSON:
