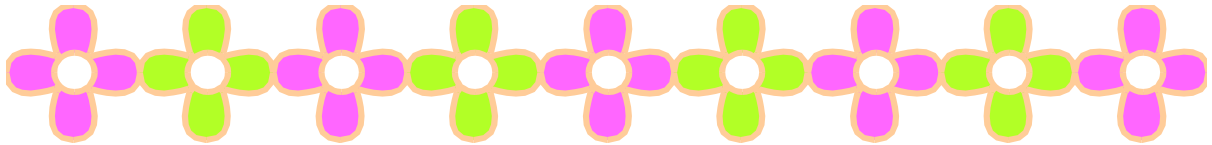

ATLANTIC CITY BUS TRIP



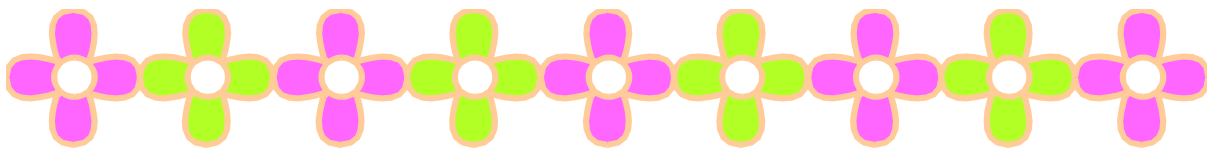
Date: Sunday, April 3rd Bus leaves Paramus Woman's Club @ 9am
