WOMAN'S CLUB GIANT PARKING LOT GARAGE SALE.

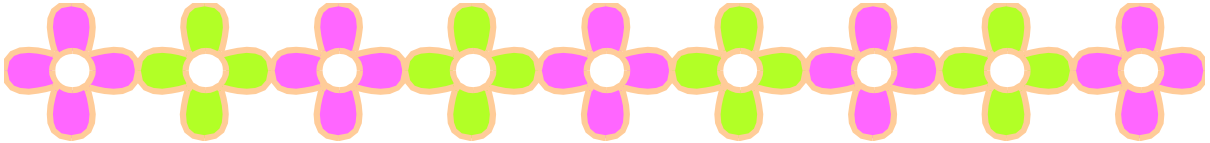
Saturday, June 4th, 8am-4pm. Rain or Shine.

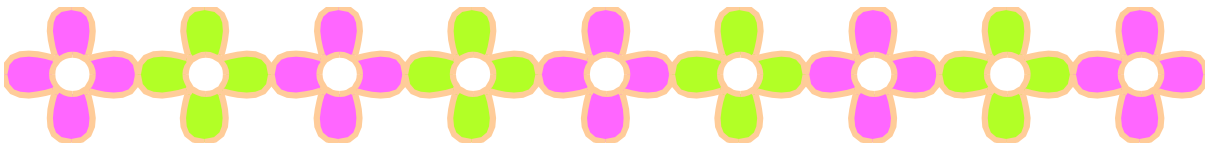
